

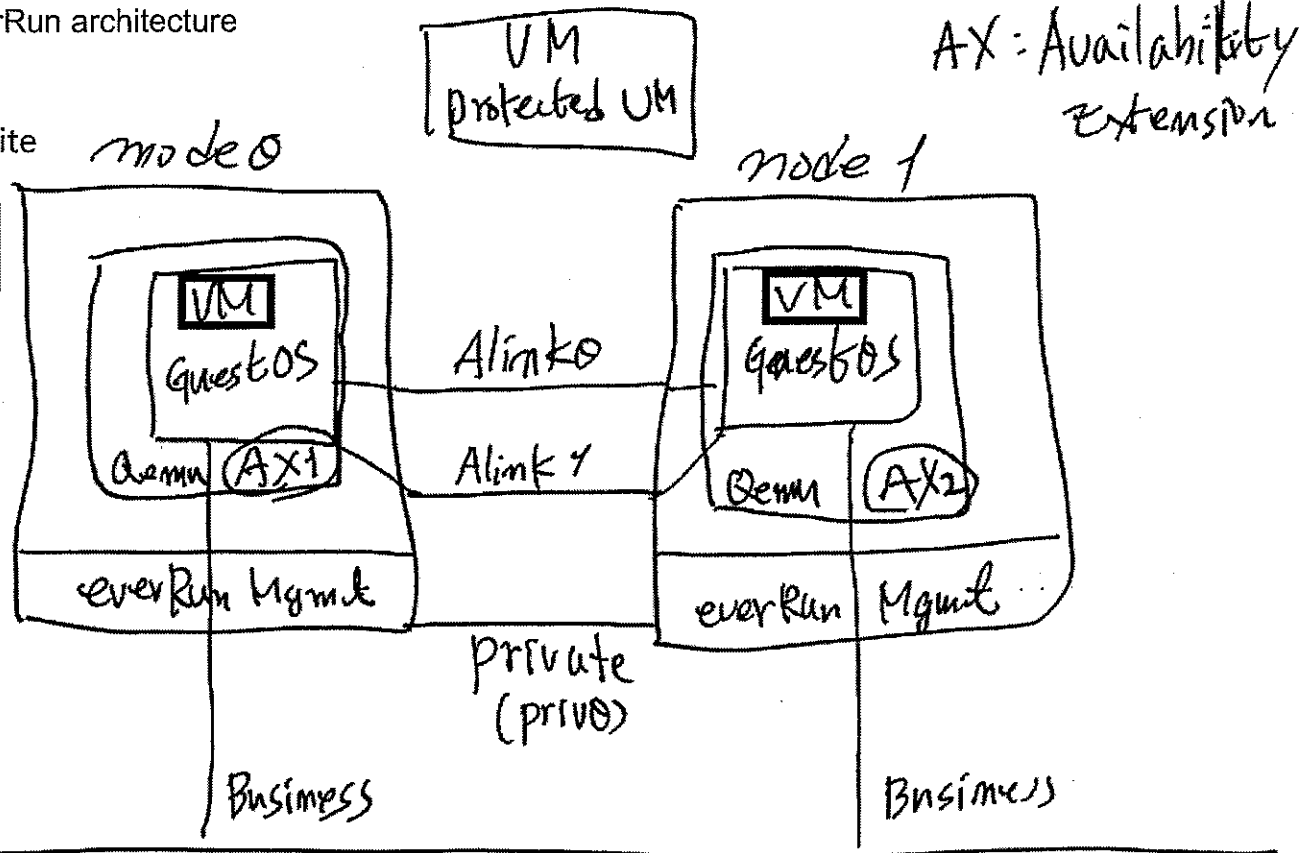

HA: Disk/I/O

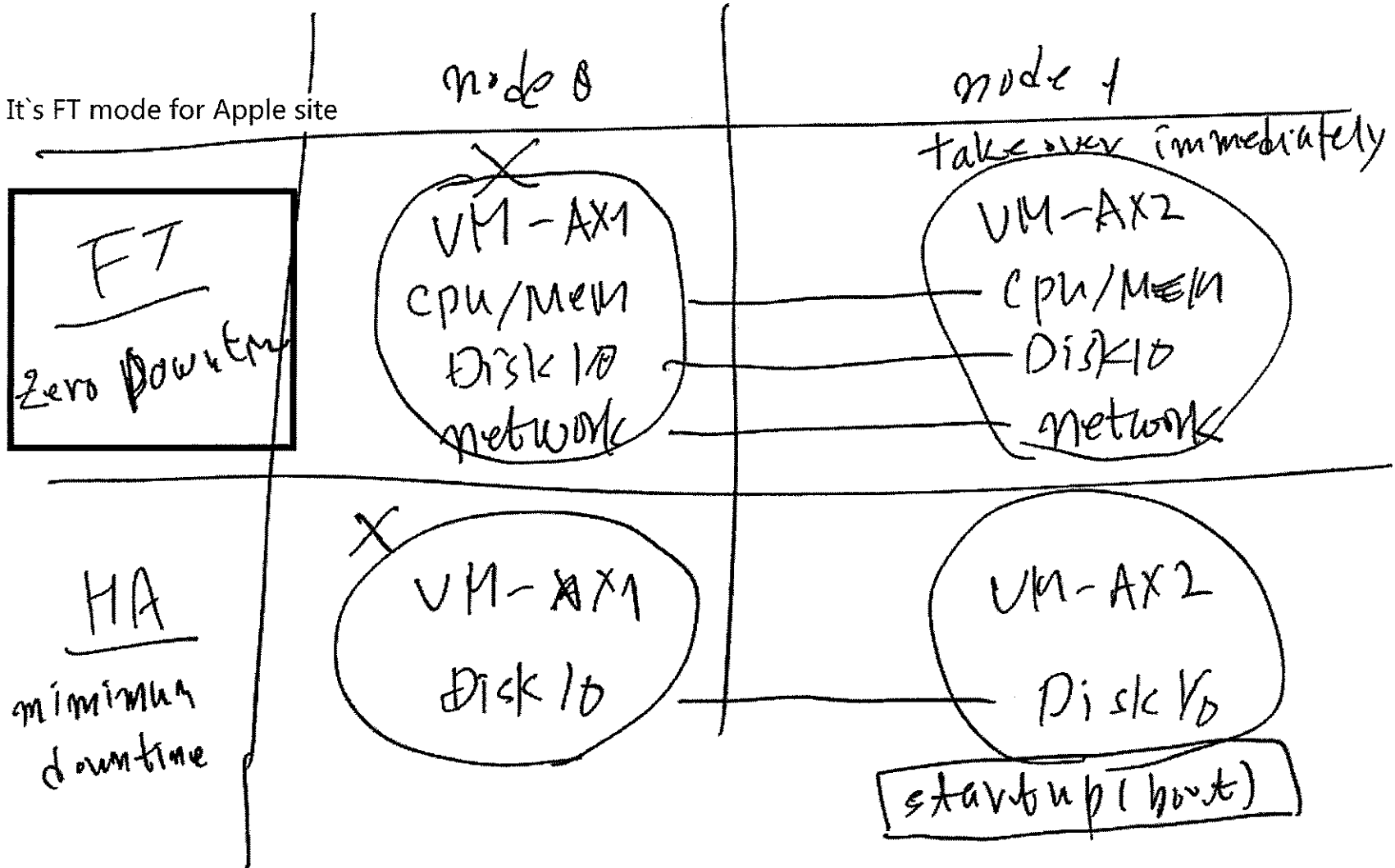
EverRun has 2 VMs



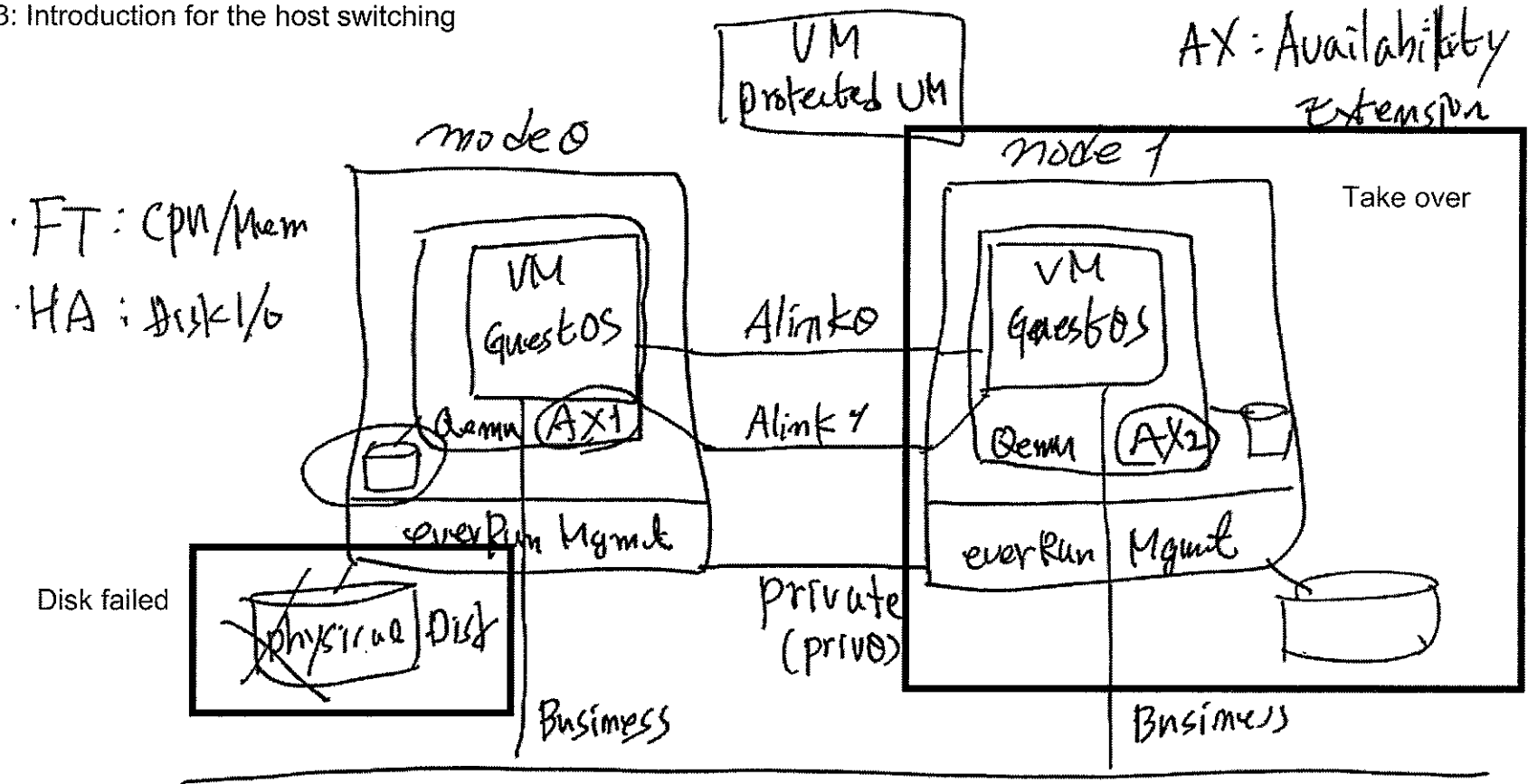
Two-Brain: Management / FT-CORE (AX)

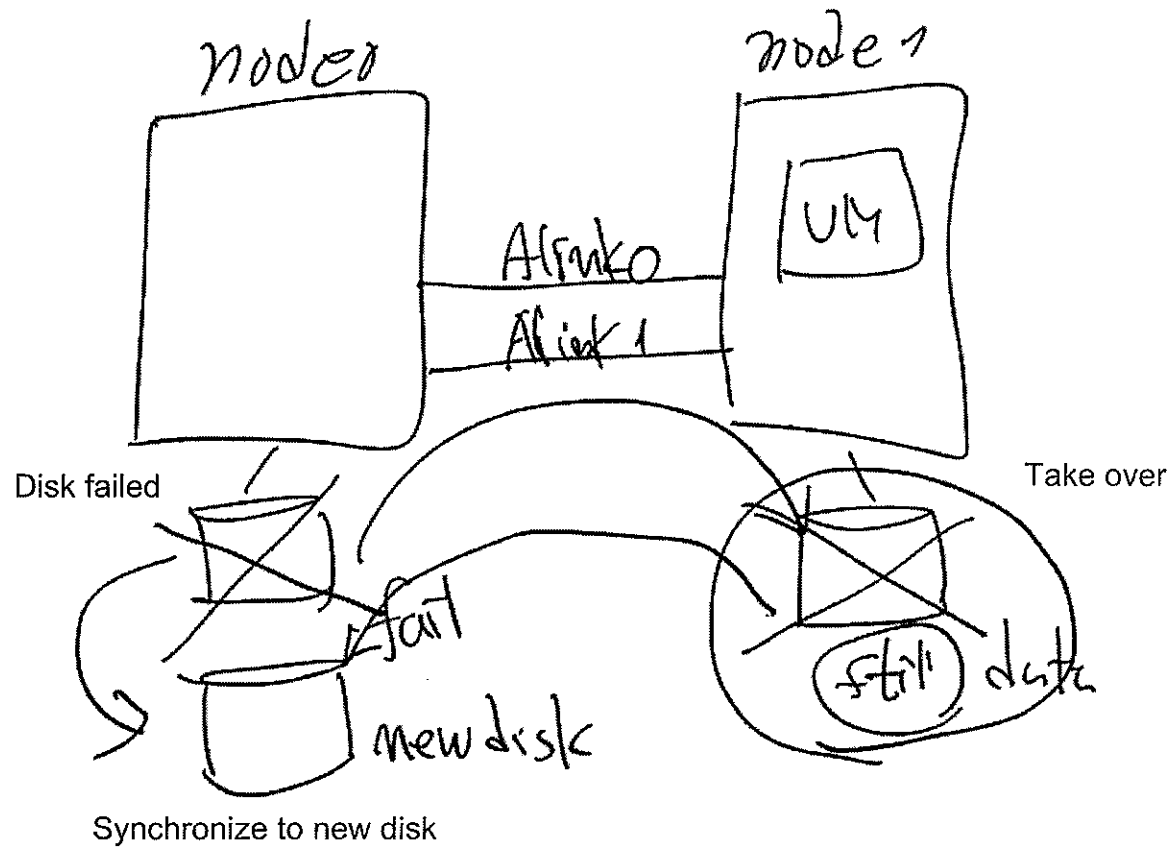

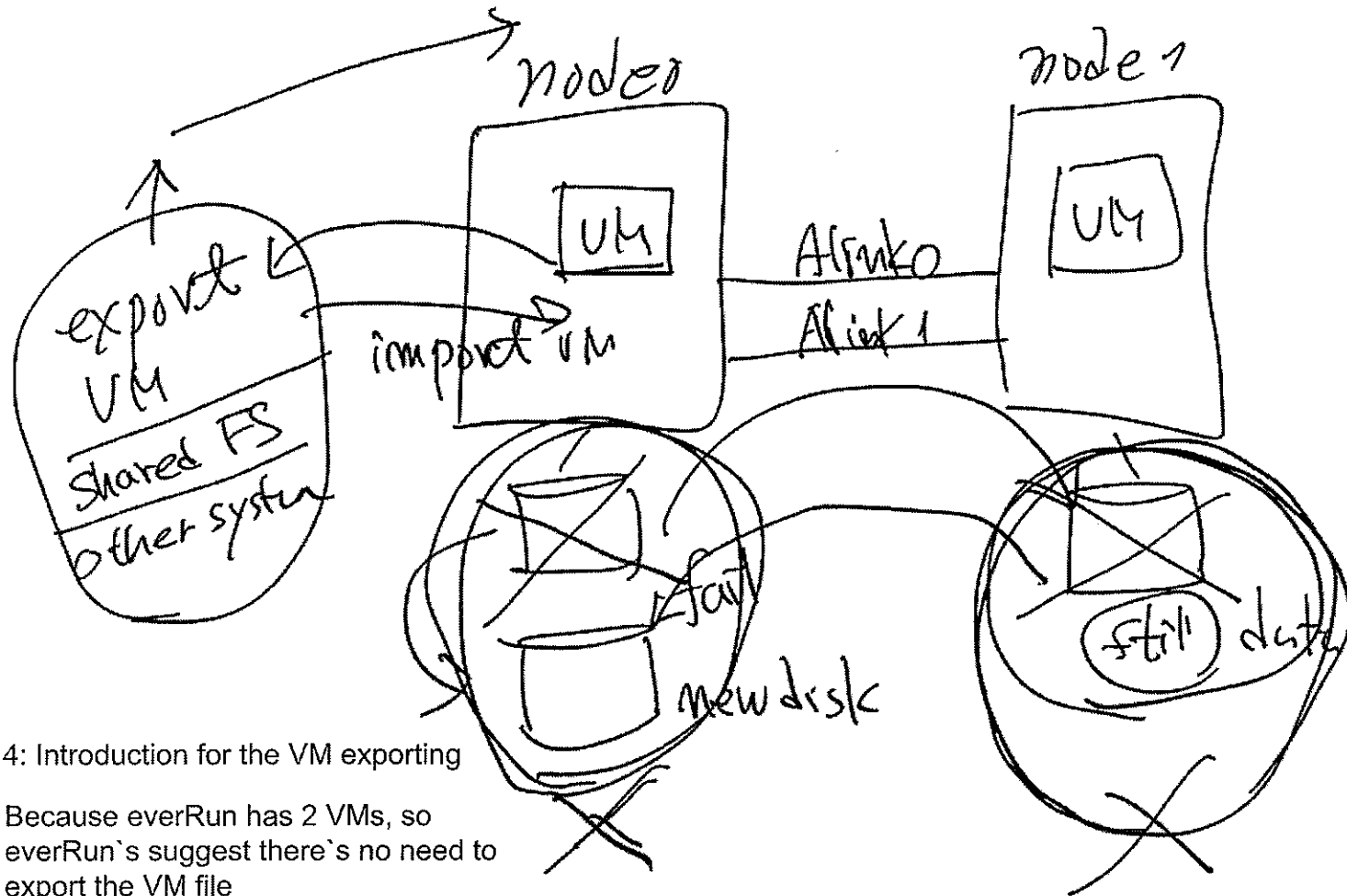
